

2024 AMHERST SAFETY TOWN

Safety Town is a 5-day interactive educational program that is designed to educate children on a variety of safety topics and techniques that can be utilized in real life situations. Children are given basic instruction on traffic, train, and pedestrian safety, emergencies and 911 use, stranger danger, gun and seat belt safety, and school bus procedures and safety. There will also be a visit to the fire station for a day spent learning fire safety with members of our fire department. Also, an important goal is for each child to be able to state their full name, address and phone number and we ask that parents work with their child prior to attending.

Class instruction will be directed by School Resource Officers, Ryan Lamb and Sean Gawlik, along with youth volunteers from the Amherst schools who will be present daily. The children will spend part of their days outdoors (weather permitting) learning how to stay safe in our mini town that includes crosswalks, traffic signals, and stop signs. They will ride around the town on pedal cars with supervision from our staff. The other part of their days will be spent indoors in a classroom setting. Guest speakers from Lifecare Ambulance, 911, and Amherst School Transportation will also visit.

The Amherst Safety Town program will be held the weeks of June 10th and June 17th at the Amherst Beaver Creek Reservation Visitor's Center located at 913 North Lake Street. Morning sessions (9:30am - 11:30am) and afternoon sessions (1:00pm - 3:00pm) are offered each week. Class space is limited, and spots are filled on a first come, first serve basis. Please indicate your session preference (1st, 2nd, 3rd, <u>and</u> 4th) on the registration form and we will do our best to accommodate your requests. However, session preferences are not guaranteed. Graduation will be held on Friday of each week -- 11:00 am for the morning sessions and 2:30 pm for the afternoon sessions. Parents and family members are encouraged to join us for the ceremonies.

Participating children must be entering Kindergarten in the Amherst School District this fall or reside within the City of Amherst and attending kindergarten elsewhere. Children should wear weather/activity appropriate clothing and shoes. For safety reasons, flip flops or open-toe shoes are not permitted. Also, for the safety of your child, we recommend that no dresses or Crocs are worn during the week.

Please complete the attached registration and KidPrint forms and return to the Amherst Police Department by Monday, May 6th. We cannot accept registration after this date due to program preparation time, so please be sure to register on time. A \$40.00 fee is required at the time of registration, which includes a T-shirt and daily snack for each child. Payment can be made by cash, check, or money order (made payable to Amherst Safety Town). Forms and payment can be brought in or mailed to Amherst Safety Town, 911 North Lake St, Amherst, OH 44001. Parents will be notified by email with confirmation on which session your child has been assigned to. Class confirmation notices will be sent to the email address provided within 2 weeks of receiving your forms. *If you do not receive a message to your Inbox, please remember to check your junk/spam folder also.*

* Safety Town sessions will go on as scheduled rain or shine.
