A-20-29 2019 Sidewalk Program County Assessment Documents;
Pursuant to law department recommendation, assessment ordinance cannot be created until after the August 1, 2020 invoice payment deadline has expired. Assessment documentation required to be submitted to the County Auditor no later than September 14, 2020 to be certified for placement onto the 2021 tax rolls for each affected parcel.

Mayor Costilow explained this is part of the process of the sidewalk program. He said the residents were given as much time as possible to make payments for these assessments. He asked for emergency.

Mr. Macartney referred to a e mail he had sent out to everyone answering Mr. Janik's question. Mayor Costilow spoke to this and said we would like be as accommodating as we can. Mr. Janik also spoke of his concerns of the residents who had not repaired their sidewalks in a timely manner, and have had more time than other residents to make their repairs. He is worried that someone on the list may come and ask why these people did not have to pay and they did and this could become a source of litigation. Mr. Macartney explained. These people will be on the next year's list. He gave an example of how they work with the residents.

Mr. Dembinski motioned to send this to the floor of Council with the emergency. Seconded by Mr. Heberling. Roll call vote 7-0 to send to the floor of council with the emergency.
