Ms. Harmych and Mrs. Miller were absent and had letters on file. Mr. Nahorn motioned to excuse Ms. Harmych and Mrs. Miller as they had letters on file. Seconded by Mr. Wachholz. Voice vote 6-0 to excuse Ms. Harmych and Mrs. Miller. Mr. Pecora introduced the new assistant Law Director Rachel Reinbolt and Prosecutor Zach Simonoff. Former Assistant Law Director Patrick Ward was both the City Prosecutor and Assistant Law Director and has retired from his position.

A-26-30 An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract for professional service with Bramhall Engineering and surveying Company Relating to the OPWC State Issue 1 - Round 40 N. Leavitt rehabilitations project; emergency.
