Minutes of the Streets Committee Meeting held June 10, 2024, at 6:45 P.M. Present in Council Chambers were Chairman Nahorn, Mr. Winiarski, Ms. Harmych, Mr. Heberling, Mr. Janik, Mr. Wachholz, Mr. Dembinski, President of Council Wasilk, Mayor Costilow, Safety/Service Director Jeffreys, Law Director Pecora, Assistant Law Director Ward, Treasurer Ramsey and Auditor Phillips. Also present were Mrs. Sandy Kaiser, Executive Director of the Amherst Historical Society, and members Mr. Jerry Gach, Mr. Todd Standen and Mrs. Pat Standen.

A-24-26 The Amherst Historical Society is requesting a partial street vacation of the northern 213'-218' portion of Jefferson Street from the northern property line of 149 Jefferson Street (PP No. 05-00-003-112-005) north to railroad property (PP No. 05-00-003-500-001) owned by Pennsylvania Lines LLC. The City shall reserve all rights for utilities within the vacated portion of Jefferson Street as a perpetual easement.

Mayor Costilow spoke to the matter. Amherst Historical Society has spoken to him and they wish to consolidate lots. He felt it was simple request. They have discussed this with city departments. Mrs. Sandy Kaiser spoke on the matter and explained they have 11 parcels now. What they are requesting is an unused portion of Jefferson Street. She explained the benefits of the vacation.

Mr. Winiarski asked about the neighbors and Mr. Todd Standen of 149 Jefferson spoke and said they have no problems with this now that they know it will not affect their property.

Mr. Dembinski researched this question and spoke to Amherst Fire Department and they have no concerns about this.

Mr. Dembinski motioned to take this to the floor of Council. Seconded by Mr. Wachholz. Voice vote 7-0 to send to the floor of council.

Mr. Dembinski motioned to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Wachholz. Voice vote 7-0 to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 6:51 P. M.
